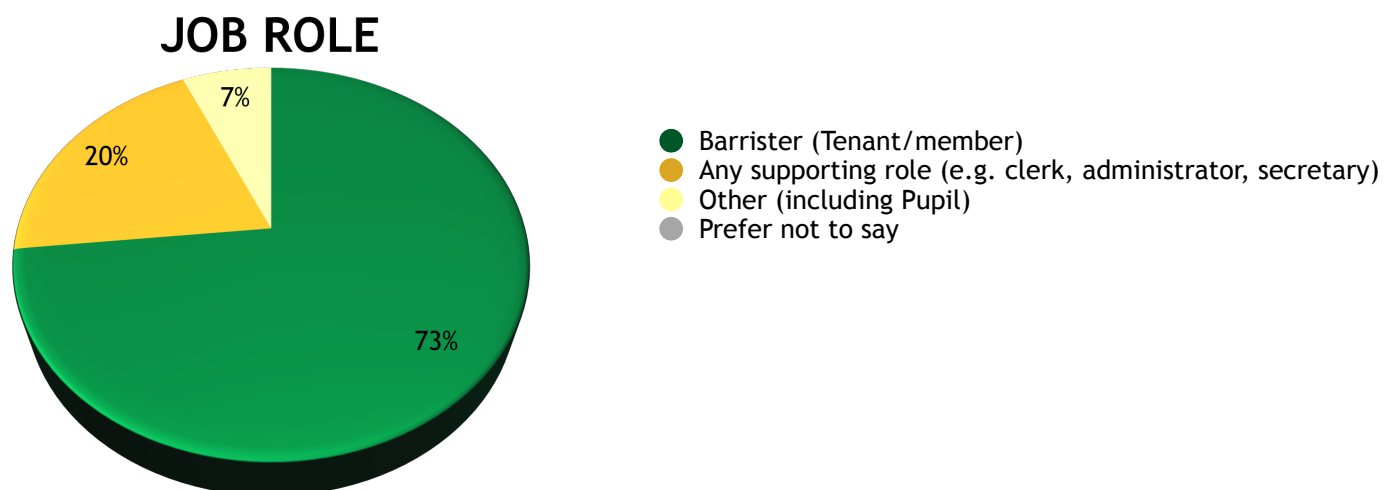


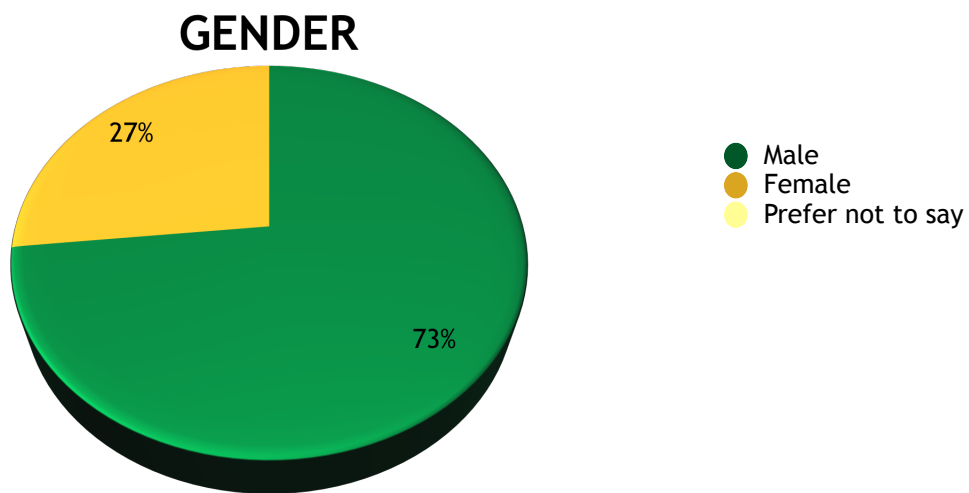
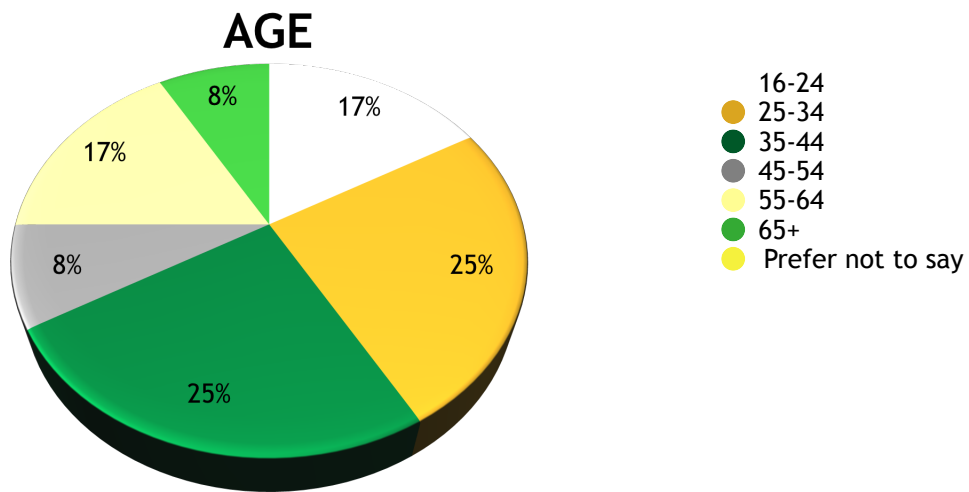


EQUITY CHAMBERS' DIVERSITY DATA 2020

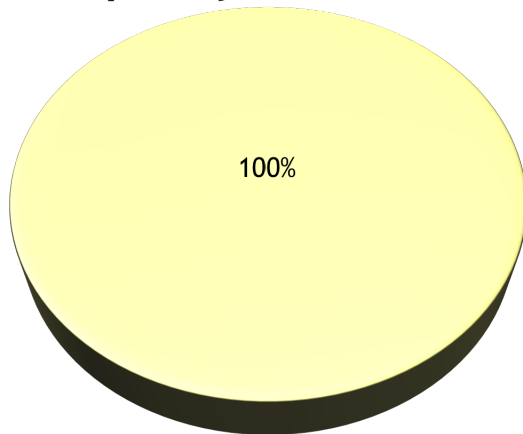

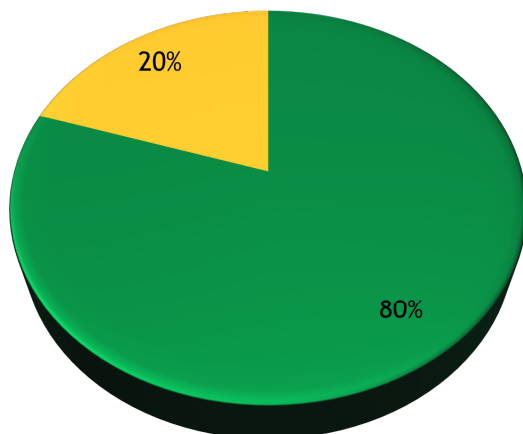
DISABILITY

Do you consider yourself to have a disability according to the definition provided in The Equality Act 2010?



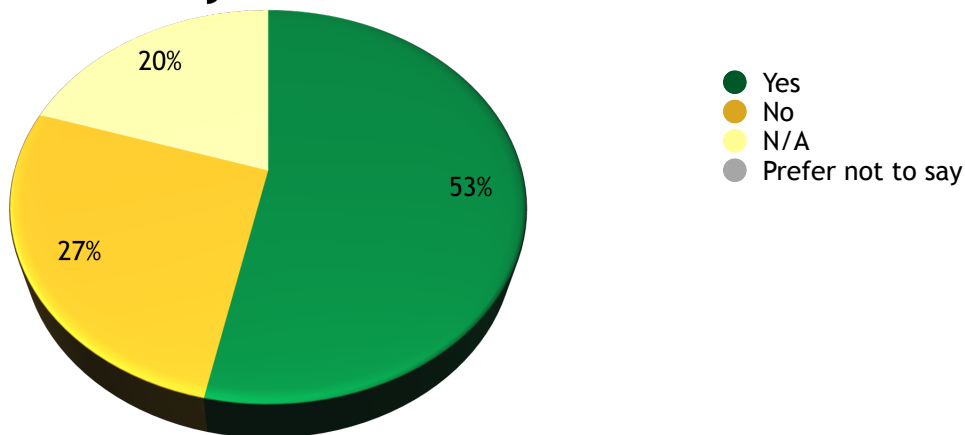

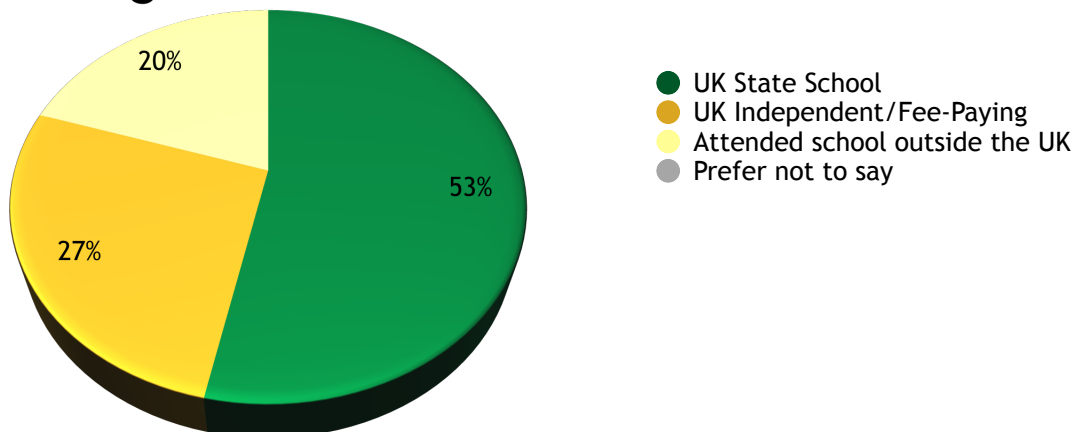

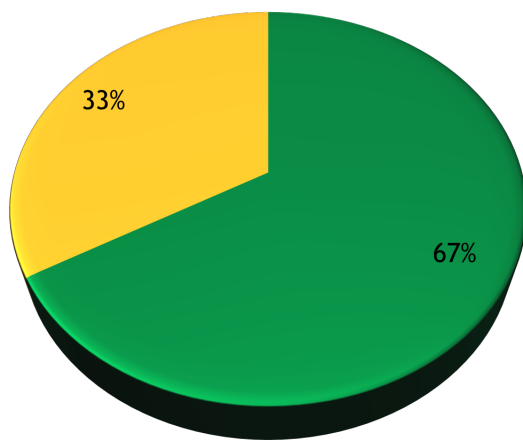

ages of 11-18?

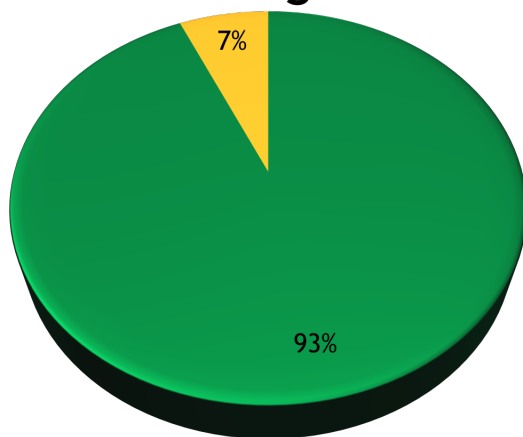
